**1. DATES**

- 1.1. The Springtime Regatta and the BC Youth Circuit Event shall be May 19 and 20, 2007
- 1.2. The Youth World Qualifiers shall be May 19-21, 2007

**2. RULES**

- 2.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined by The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 2.2. The Prescriptions of the Canadian Yachting Association will apply and will be posted on the Official Notice Board
- 2.3. Changes to the Racing Rules will appear in the Sailing Instructions.
- 2.4. If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

**3. ADVERTISING**

Advertising will be restricted to Category A.

**4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 4.1. The Springtime Regatta is available to all classes.
- 4.2. The Canadian Youth World Team Qualifier is restricted to sailors under 19 years of age by December 31, 2007 (Born after December 31, 1988).
- 4.3. The boat for the Open entry, Canadian Youth World Team Qualifier shall be the Hobie 16SE

**5. CLASSIFICATION**

The ISAF Sailor Classification Code will apply.

**6. FEES**

**7. SCHEDULE**

- 7.1. Registration will be from 0730 and 0900 hours, Saturday, May 19<sup>th</sup>.
- 7.2. The scheduled time of the warning signal each day is 1000 hours.
- 7.3. No sequence shall be started after 1430 hours on Sunday, May 20<sup>th</sup> for the Springtime Regatta and the BC Youth Event.
- 7.4. No sequence shall be started after 1330 hours on Monday, May 21<sup>st</sup>, for the ISAF Youth World Qualifiers.

**8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

The Sailing Instructions will be available after 0730 hours on May 19<sup>th</sup> at the Registration desk.

**9. VENUE**

Racing will take place in the waters of Okanagan Lake adjacent to the Central Okanagan Sailing Association.

## 10. COURSES

The courses will appear in the Sailing Instructions.

## 11. SCORING

11.1. The Low Point scoring system of Appendix A 4.1 will apply

11.2. 11 races are scheduled of which one must be completed to constitute a series.

11.3. If 5 races are completed a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score..

## 12. PRIZES

There shall be prizes awarded to the first three boats of any class of more than 7 boats.
